**Richard W Gibney RLA** Principal of Gibney Design Landscape Architecture PC in Wading River, NY  
Richard is a New York State registered Landscape Architect, ISA Certified Arborist, past president of the ASLA New York Chapter (1994-95), New York State Council of Landscape Architects (2008-09) and the Design Professionals Coalition of Long Island (2007-08). He holds degrees in ornamental horticulture and landscape architecture from SUNY Farmingdale and Cornell University. His firm Gibney Design LA PC has served public, private and institutional clients since 1986.

**Mina Vecera** Extension Educator and Nursery & Landscape Specialist for Cornell Cooperative Extension of Suffolk Co. Mina holds a bachelor's degree in forestry from the University of Massachusetts at Amherst and a master's in biology and environmental science from the University of Rhode Island at Kingston. Prior to joining Cornell Cooperative Extension, Mina spent eleven years in Downeast Maine working as an estate gardener on Mount Desert Island and managing her own company, Sundew Gardening Services, specializing in native and organic gardening. She also spent three seasons working for Acadia National Park as an Interpretive Ranger giving informational park tours. Additionally, Mina has experience in sustainable vegetable production and has a passion for plant propagation.

**Dennis Schrader** Owner/Operator of Landcraft Environments, Ltd. in Mattituck, NY  
Dennis is one of the foremost experts in the country on plant production and garden design. He is a professional horticulturist with a degree in Landscape Design and Nursery Management from the State University of New York at Cobleskill.
